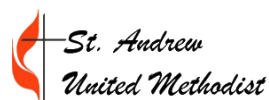

In remembrance of the one year anniversary of Hurricane Michael, we will collect a special offering in all services on Oct. 6 to help further the recovery efforts.

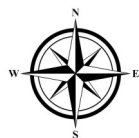
